

Annual Costas T. Lambrew Maine Medical Center Research Retreat



The annual Maine Medical Center Research Retreat was held on May 3, 2017 at the Dana Center. To honor the legacy of Costas T. Lambrew, M.D., MMC's research retreat will now carry his name: The Annual Costas T. Lambrew Maine Medical Center Research Retreat. The naming recognizes the many contributions of Dr. Lambrew to the academic mission and culture at MMC over his decades of service.

The keynote speaker for this year's retreat was Dr. Vasan Ramachandra, the Principal Investigator of the Framingham Heart Study and Professor of Medicine and Epidemiology at Boston University School of Medicine. In addition research was featured from 20 different departments and divisions at Maine Medical Center and the Maine Medical Center Research Institute (MMCRI) in the areas of basic/translational science, medical education, quality improvement, and clinical/population health. Seven abstracts were selected from competitive field for oral presentations and there were over 75 poster presentations; as well as small group sessions.

The retreat ended successfully with naming and awards ceremony. Next year's Costas T. Lambrew Maine Medical Center Research Retreat is scheduled for May 2, 2018.
